<p>Make something which uses pulleys and gears or electrical circuits to show the class. Include instructions for someone else to make.</p> 	<p>Design and create an invention of your own. Think about what your invention will do and what its purpose is.</p> 	<p>Research Victorian Street children. Write a recount describing what a day in your life is like.</p> 
<p>Your choice - Be creative. Make up a dance, song, poem, music. Produce some art, sculpture, food. Build a model, make a game. Share it with the class.</p> 	<p>Read a chapter book and write a book review. Explain what you thought about the book. What genre / theme was it? Who were your favourite characters and why? How would you rate it and why?</p> 	<p>Create a story board based on 'The Lost Thing'. You can use this in ICT to create an animation.</p>
