E-Safety Talks

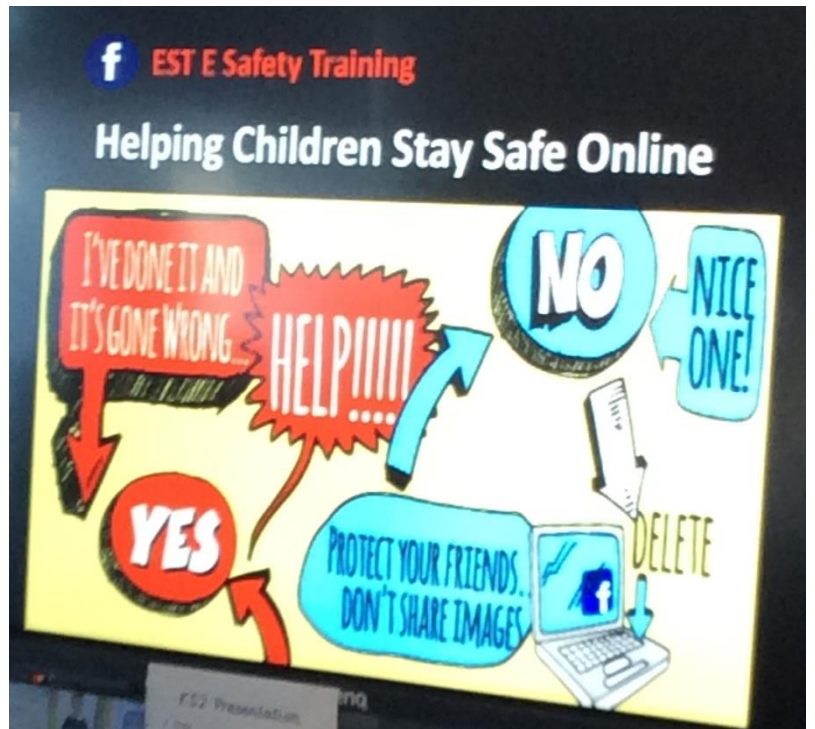
The children in KS1 and 2 went to Waterman on Wednesday and met the two Johns, ex-police officers, who talked to them about keeping safe on line.

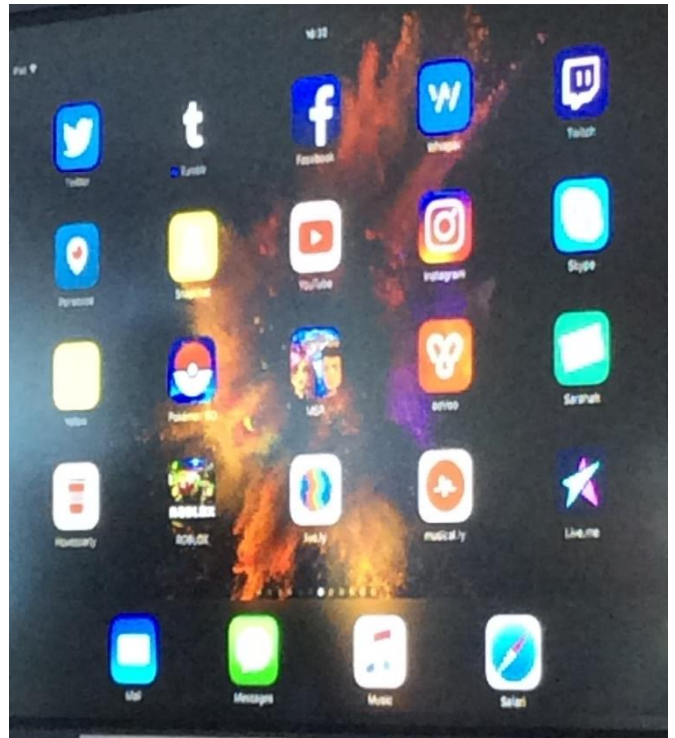
