The Regulations place a greater emphasis on organisations to only collect information that is necessary, to keep it safe, and to delete it immediately it is no longer needed. We would like to assure parents and carers that we reviewing our systems across the Trust to ensure we will be GDPR compliant before the regulations come into force.
