Singing songs and rhymes - learning nursery rhymes

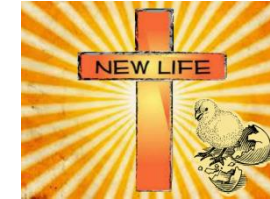
## Expressive Art and Design
